The Team

We are entering a BMW M4 GT3 Evo in the 2025-2026 Asian Le Mans Series. The BMW has been winning races globally and along with Eurasia it results in a powerful combination.

Eurasia Motorsport is a multi-championship winning team with global racing experience in Le Mans, WEC, ELMS and IMSA. We provided management and technical support to the 2024 GTWC Australia champions and are doing the same in 2025.

Seven seasons of Asian Le Mans, including a championship winning campaign, can provide assurance to our drivers that we will be fully competitive.

Eurasia Motorsport in an International company registered in Hong Kong and founded in 2004 with a base at the Sepang International Circuit in Malaysia

We have managed and run cars to championship victories in Asian Le Mans LMP3, GT Asia, Blancpain GT Series Asia, Asian Le Mans Sprint Series, F.BMW, F.Pilota, F.Masters and TCR Asia International.

We are race winners in LMP2 Asian Le Mans, GT Asian Le Mans, China LMP3 and Asian F.BMW

We have competed for two seasons in the European Le Mans Series finishing in the top six overall in the Championship both times. We have taken part in five Le Mans 24h and two Daytona 24h.

We are currently providing management and technical support to the two car championship leading Ferrari 296 GT3 entry of Arise Racing GT in the 2025 GT World Challenge Australia after winning the championship in 2024

Now firmly established as a major Championship the ACO have continued to offer six x four races over a compacted schedule.




Track Time



Le Mans 24 Hours Automatic Entry



- Eurasia Motorsport has competed in the LMP2 Class of the Le Mans 24 Hours five times and is ideally placed to run a car in the iconic race.



Regulations

- Tyres per event: 2 sets for Free Practice, 1 set for qualifying, 4.5 sets for Race One and
 4 .5 sets for Race Two
- Michelin Tyres
- No minimum mandatory pit stop time for GT
- Safety car pass-a-round ensures close racing
- VSC (Virtual Safety Car) and FCY also used
- ACO Race Control and Scrutineering as used in ELMS and WEC


Media Values

Media values have been growing year on year. What follows are the media values for the 2022-2023 season.


Media values for the 2024-2025 will be published in July of this year.

Asian Le Mans Series Audience





Coverage in China












The Asian Le Mans Series reach into China continues to grow significantly even with the absence of a Chinese round of the Championship.


